I'm selling this horse because I'm going to go to Breyerfest in KY this August, and would like to pay some of the costs! I'll be bringing my airbrush and painting and finishing several custom models during the event, which will then be for sale!

AUCTION TERMS:

Because I want to wrap it up fast, and because I'm not too happy with the way phone auctions work, (the winner is usually the one lucky enough to

be the last person to get through) this will be a ONE-BID ONLY auction. Anyone wishing to bid must send in ONE written bid ONLY, by the deadline. Decide what the horse is worth to you, and bid that amount! There will NOT be a chance to raise your bid. I will NOT give out the current high bid prior to the deadline, so all bidders will have an equal chance that theirs will be the highest bid. (Don't call or write to ask for the current bid--it will not be given to anyone!) Only the high bidder will be notified by me after the deadline, so no SASE is necessary. If you would like to know what the high bid was AFTER the auction, send a SASE. Time payment offers will be considered, but must be paid off in full in 60 days, 25% down. Trades also considered for PAM in SR black or test colors, or Old Mold PAM's, (not white), H-R's, older Beswicks.
